

BYLAW 862

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BIG VALLEY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING AN ADVERTISEMENT BYLAW

WHEREAS; Section 606.1 of the *Municipal Government Act* allows a council to pass a bylaw to provide for one or more methods, which may include electronic means, for advertising proposed bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings and other things referred to in section 606.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Big Valley, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, wishes to enact the following:

1. TITLE

1.1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Advertisement Bylaw".

2. APPLICATION

2.1. This Bylaw applies in instances when the *Municipal Government Act* or another enactment requires a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or something else to be advertised by the Village of Big Valley, unless the *Municipal Government Act* or another enactment specifies otherwise.

3. ADVERTISING

3.1 Notice of the bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing must be advertised for a minimum of two (2) consecutive weeks prior to the date of the bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing as follows:

- a) Publication in the Valley Whistle, and
- b) Posted on the Village of Big Valley website
- c) At the Village Administration Office bulletin board.

3.2 In addition, at the discretion of the Chief Administrative Officer, notice may also be provided as follows:

- a) To every residence in the area to which the proposed bylaw, resolution, or other thing relates to by regular mail, or if the resident has agreed, by email or other electronic means; and
- b) Posting the information about the notices on the Village of Big Valley social media sites.




