Highlights from October 13, 2022 Organizational and Regular Council Meetings

The Organizational meeting was held prior to the Regular Council meeting. Dan Houle was appointed and sworn in as Mayor and Amber Hoogenberg was appointed and sworn in as Deputy Mayor. Council selected the committees and boards they wished to be on to represent the Village – to see those please visit our website at www.villageofbigvalley.ca >Our Community>Municipal Information>Village Council and Staff.

Council has moved the start time of all Regular Council meetings. They will begin at 7:00 p.m. instead of 6:30 p.m. They will continue to be held the second Thursday of each month in the Village Office.

Following the Organizational meeting, the Regular Council meeting was called to order. Mayor Houle started the meeting by welcoming Councillor Clark German back to Council and noted that Council is looking forward to working with Councillor German.

The auditor presented Council with the audited financial statements for 2021 and those were approved by Council. The financial statements can also be found on our website following the same directions as the Council Committee list.

The water tower cladding has been paused while we wait for another roll of the material to be shipped. There was a colour discrepancy, and this is being corrected. The new material is expected to take 7-10 days to arrive and then the work will be completed.

The next Regular Council meeting will be Nov. 10, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.
