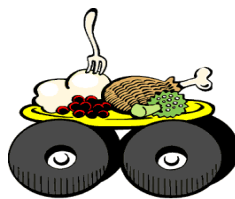

Highlights from May 11, 2023 Regular Council Meeting

A Public Hearing was held regarding the sale of land adjacent to the train station. Council and Canadian Northern Society were committed to answer all questions asked. Overall, there were no concerns with the sale of land and the sale will proceed.

Council approved a portion of Main Street to be closed on June 17th, 2023 from 12:00 p.m. (noon) until 7:00 p.m. for the East Bound and Down Poker Rally. This closure will affect Main Street from Railway Avenue to 1st Ave as well as 1st Ave from the north alleyway beside the Village Shop to south alleyway behind the Store.

Council approved a portion of Main Street, from Railway Avenue to 2nd Avenue, leaving parking access in front of the Villa's for Villa residents, be closed on July 22nd, 2023 from 12:00 p.m. (noon) until 12:00 am (midnight) for the 2023 Big Valley Street Festival.
