### Village News

#### Regular Council Meeting – July 15<sup>th</sup>

Village Council met this past Monday for their scheduled monthly Council Meeting; Staff Sargeant Cam Russell , and answered questions put forth.

Issues relating to a sewer line, in the SW corner of the Village wherein the gravity fed line at the end of the line was freezing during really cold spells. Admin and PW will be working on finding a solution to insulate the line and avoid further freeze ups.

A property owner's request to lease a portion of land from the Village was found to be unnecessary as that same property was part of the land owned by that property owner. Bylaw 881 – Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw was introduced and received all three readings. A copy has been posted to the Village website.

Bylaw 875 – Nuisance Abatement Bylaw – Letters being sent to property owners for unsightly yards.

Council approved the use of Village property along the rail line, and Round House for the Bike Packing Event this coming weekend.

The Village John Deere Tractor repair will be discussed at the August Council Meeting. Administration have been requested to put signage up prior to this weekend's Rodeo, Bike Packing Event, as well as campground for the Fire Restriction issued by the County of Stettler currently in place
