FIRE BAN INFORMATION EFFECTIVE 16:00 JULY 23, 2024

As a result of continued extreme dry weather, high temperatures and wind conditions, a **FIRE BAN** is in effect for the County of Stettler.

All outdoor fires presently burning within the County of Stettler No. 6 should be extinguished immediately. The ignition of all new outdoor fires is prohibited.

Off-highway vehicles and farming equipment can start wildfires - **INSPECT YOUR EQUIPMENT** frequently to ensure hot spots are free of debris, and make sure mufflers and spark arrestors are working properly.

This **FIRE BAN** does not apply to:

- Fires, which are contained within cooking and heating appliances and which are fueled by propane, natural gas or wood pellets
- Fires contained within industrial facilities for operational purposes
- Approved Gas/Propane fueled fire pits/stoves/barbecues
- Catalytic or infrared-style heaters

For greater clarity this **FIRE BAN** includes, but is not limited to:

- Recreational fires
- Burn Barrels
- Discharge of fireworks
- Use of exploding targets
- Charcoal Barbeques
- Any other form of outside burning unless exempted above

Conditions will be monitored. We will update the public on any changes.

This **FIRE BAN** will remain in effect until further notice.
