Cats running at large continue to frustrate local residents, including stray cats, as well as those cats belonging to a household, and whom are let out to run. Every cat owner is required by Bylaw to register them at the Village Office every year. If you have a cat(s), 3 are allowed per residence; it is the pet owner's responsibility to have each of them licensed, and to control where their cat(s) goes, i.e. collar and leash, and keeping them on your property. Working in your garden or flowerbed shouldn't mean you should find cat dung left behind to deal with. Penalties for cat owners which are in place that can be issued at any given time, but are not limited to the following:

	1 st Offence	2 nd Offence	3 rd Offence
Failure to obtain license	\$50;	\$100;	\$500
Running at large	\$50;	\$100;	\$500
Failure to ensure collar/tag worn	\$50;	\$100;	\$500
Failure to remove defecation	\$50;	\$100;	\$500
Keeping more than 3 cats of licensed age	\$200	\$400;	\$500
