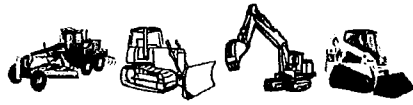

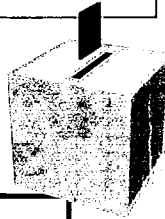

This FIRE BAN does not apply to:

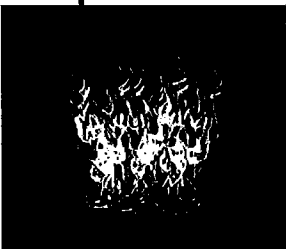
- Fires which are contained within cooking and heating
