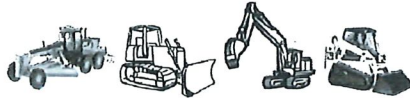

Village News

- During their Regular Meeting on July 21, Village Council discussed Sealed Bid RFP-2025-01 Road Construction on 4th Ave. Tender packages which were distributed to several companies with a deadline to submit no later than July 31st. A Special Meeting has been scheduled for August 5, 2025 to open the bids and go from there.
- Public Works is also in the process of clearing cattails at the lagoon, and obtaining quotes for qualified companies to replace valves.

- During the next few weeks there will be crews in the Village doing crack filling, grading back alleys, and flushing sewer lines. As well, Public Works will be tree trimming, and continuing to pick up compost and delivering mulch purchased at the Office.

- As a reminder, letters are being sent out to those having unmaintained, unsightly yards per the Village's Bylaw 827 - Nuisance Abatement Bylaw. Please respect your neighbors and community by maintaining your yard including cleaning up discarded items cluttering your property. In addition, Bylaw 837 - Village of Big Valley Traffic Bylaw and for safety issues does not allow any unregistered/uninsured vehicles to be parked on Village property. The Village will be working with the RCMP to confirm, and those vehicles will be removed at the owners expense.

- As with other Alberta municipalities, the Village has been working with Occupational Health & Safety to ensure the Village is operating in a safe and compliant manner. OH&S's initiative is for the purpose of bringing all municipalities to a uniform standard. I'm happy to say with the past safety program and what is being presently worked on, the Village has had positive comments from the OH&S Officer.


