Thinking of running for the upcoming Fall Municipal Election?

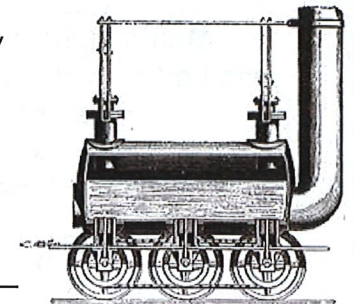
