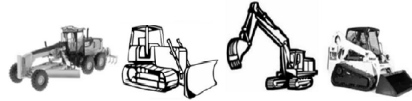

## Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) FCSS Grant Funding Applications

The Village has been contacted regarding the clarification for the use of FCSS grant funding and expected outcomes. Funding is meant for "**locally driven preventative social initiatives to enhance the well-being of individuals, families and communities**". These initiatives are required to follow similar FCSS programming which they already offer, specifying how this will be accomplished and expected outcomes. New application forms will be available at the Village Office in September, requiring FCSS guidelines be followed and filled out in full. Failure to do will mean applications may be declined; FCSS may require funding be returned to Province otherwise. Further information is available by speaking with Colleen at the Village Office.

## Upcoming Bridge Closure

Notification has been received through Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors (ATEC) that the Highway 590 McKenzie Crossing bridge over the Red Deer River will be unable to cross for up to 10 days this Fall to replace failing girders as a safety concern, and to prevent further closure. A scheduled repair date has yet to be determined; however, they will be providing updates and posting signs regarding detours.
