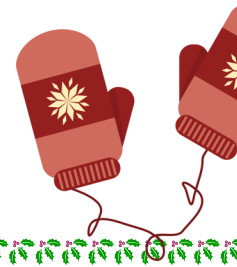

CANADA POST STRIKE ANNOUNCEMENT

Due to the Canada Post strike, Utility bills will **NOT** be mailed out until regular mail service resumes. Utility bills will be available for pick up beginning Monday, October 6, 2025. **PLEASE NOTE—ALL DEADLINES AND PENALTIES ARE STILL IN EFFECT DURING THE STRIKE.**

Residents will be able to come to the office to pick up their bills during business hours of Monday to Thursday, 8:00-4:00pm (beginning Monday, October 6,). **As an alternative we strongly encourage residents to sign up for e-billing.**

HOW DOES E-BILLING WORK?

Once you have signed up for the e-billing service, you will receive your invoices by email. Make sure to check your spam or junk as well.

HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR E-BILLING?

To sign up for the e-billing service you can either:

- Fill out the previously mailed form and drop it off at the Village office or email it to info@villageofbigvalley.ca
- Come in to the Village office and fill out the required form.

HOW DO I PAY MY UTILITY BILL OR PROPERTY TAX?

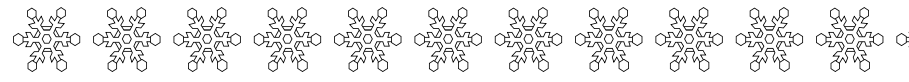
