

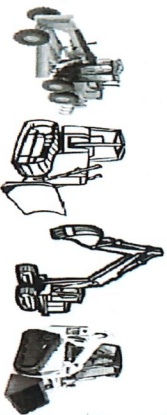

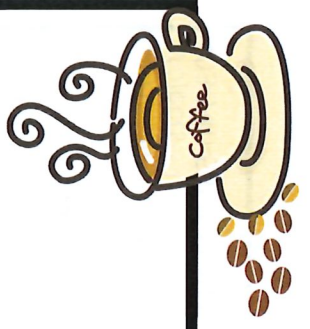

ELK HAPPENINGS

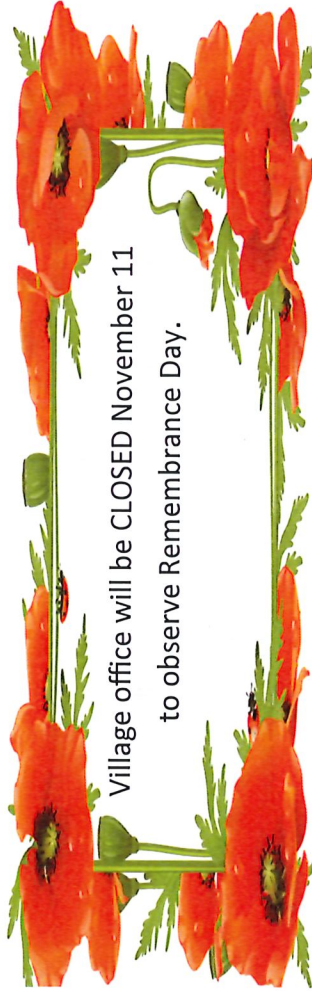
