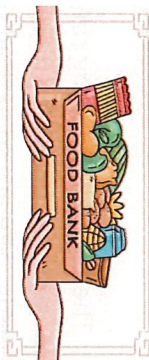

Council Meeting Highlights

Council held the regular meeting on February 11, 2026 in the Village Office.

A statistical report was presented by Staff Sergeant Russell.

The auditor presented the 2022 audited financial statements which will now be submitted to the Provincial Government.

Representatives from the Big Valley Street Festival attended with a request to close the street for the 2026 festival. This will be revisited upon receipt of some documentation requested by Council.

Direction was provided to Administration to research the golf cart pilot project currently being trialed in Alberta and bring back the information to the next Committee of the Whole meeting.

Council approved the renewal of the ATCO Gas and Pipeline Franchise Agreement for a term of 10 years, and the franchise fees will remain at 12% for the upcoming 12 months.

Council directed Administration to contact Parkland Community Planning Services to discuss revising the Land Use Bylaw.

The next meeting will be the Committee of the Whole meeting Feb. 25, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. in the Village Office.

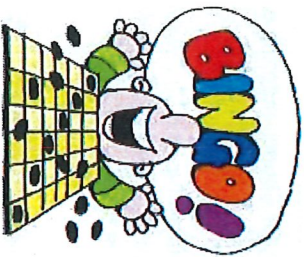

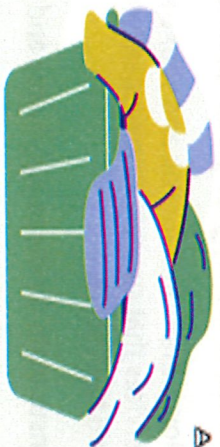
