We would like to send out a reminder to all pet owners that you are responsible for always having your pets in your care and custody. If you are walking your pet, he/she must be leashed – there is no off-leash area within the Village. If the pet is in your yard, it must not be able to escape the confines of your property, if your yard isn't fully fenced, the animals must be tied. Loose dogs have become an issue, and we will have to start fining pet owners.

In addition, it is your responsibility to clean up after your pet. If your dog/cat relieves itself outside of your property, you are to clean it up immediately. Please carry bags with you and be considerate of your neighbour's property.

Fine for animal at large = 1st offence - \$50

2nd offence - \$100

Fine for not cleaning up feces = 1st offence - \$50
