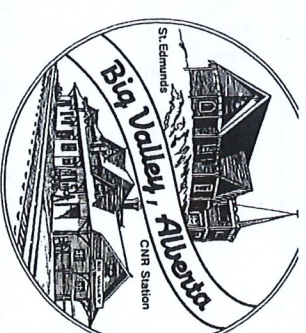

Daisy's and Buffalo Tradin' Post will be closing.

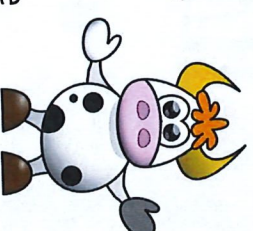
August 8 is the last day Daisy's will be open.
